Best to know Before you go

Wrightsville Beach

- Beach season is March 1st to October 31st
- Parking meters are enforced everyday during beach season
- Dogs are prohibited from April 1st through September 30th.
- Dogs are allowed on the beach from October 1st to March 31st and must be leashed

Carolina Beach

- Beach season is April 1st to September 30th
- Parking is enforced from April 1st - Oct 31st
- During the beach season dogs are allowed on the beach only from 5:00pm to 9:00am
- From October 1st to March 31st dogs are allowed on the beach during all hours
- Dogs are not permitted on the wooden parts of the boardwalk any time, nor are they allowed in the Boardwalk Business District

Kure Beach

- Beach Season is April 1st to September 30th
- No meter parking so please park legally
- Dogs are prohibited during the season no matter the time
- Dogs are allowed from October 1st to March 31st but must be leashed.
